# LOGLINE

Suffering from agoraphobia, Seconda is unable to leave her house. When she finally succeeds, new challenges push this assertive anti-heroine's limits even further.

### **SYNOPSIS**

The daily life of a 32-year-old woman suffering from agoraphobia, SECONDA, suddenly changes when her mother dies and her father abandons her. Alone and unable to leave her home, she clings to the phone messages of a snarling bailiff who one day stops calling. Unable to end her life, she offers a deal to SANTO, a bottle collector: she will give him her house in exchange for her own murder. Santo runs away, leaving Seconda alone in her despair.

The only link she has left with the outside world is the repetitive and disconcerting visits of a little girl who attacks her from the outside, pushing her to the brink.

In order to feel protected, Seconda wears her blue suit and goes out, walking in the streets of her city in search of her freedom, until she confronts her own demons that she will have to face.

A tough and determined anti-super heroine, she will achieve this with her own resources.

# AUTHOR'S NOTE OF INTENT

Non-conformist superheroes have always inspired me: the ones who stand out for their excess of humanity, their mistakes, their fears. Those who use their fragility and turn it into a weapon. Those who are out of step, on the margins and who make it their strength. This type of superhero or anti-superhero are difficult to find in the feminine gender. So I decided to create one.

This is how Seconda was born, an anti-superheroin that is an archetype of human psychological complexity, a model of the vulnerable being that transforms with her own strength. She goes forward by fighting against her own paradigms and nothing stops her.

I wanted to create a character capable of digging into the depths of isolation, until she found the light, "her" light. A character trapped by her own demons, who manages to confront them. An anti-super-heroine who inspires us with her firmness, courage, strength, but also with her fragility, precariousness, vulnerability and above all with her uncertainty, because this is what makes a fictional character true and human.

Love Me Tender tells the story of a woman who lives on the fringes of the world and who suddenly finds herself catapulted out of her comfort zone, having to confront the outside world, instigating new challenges.

Her story is that of a life journey, an existential quest, a passage that other people may make at one time or another in their lives.

## KLAUDIA REYNICKE – Writer & Director

Klaudia Reynicke is a Swiss Peruvian scriptwriter and film director. Before dedicating herself to film, she studied visual arts and sociology. In 2005 she attended the Tisch School of Arts at the NY University where she directed her first short. Later, her encounter with the Swiss director Jacqueline Veuve whom she assisted during 2006, confirmed her desire to become a film director herself. In 2010 she obtained a M.A. in filmmaking from the ECAL-HEAD. *Love Me Tender* is her 2nd feature film.

# **BARBARA GIORDANO - Seconda**

She studied at the Silvio D'Amico National Academy of Dramatic Art. She made her debut at the age of 15 as a protagonist at the Teatro Stabile in Catania in I Beati Paoli directed by G. Di Pasquale. Before being the protagonist of Love Me Tender she starred in Meraviglioso Boccaccio by the Fratelli Taviani (2015). For television she participated in the TV series 1994 (2018), Prima Che La Notte, tv movie on Raiuno (2017), Don Matteo 9 (2015) and many others. In theater she starred in Pescheria Giacalone e Figli, by Rosario Lisma, Malia directed by Armando Pugliese (2019), Ocunto di O' Surdato, by Lello Arena (2018), Edipo a Colonio by Glauco Mauri (2018/2017), Edipo Re, by A. Baracco (2017) and others. Her mother was well-known actress Mariella Lo Giudice. At the age of 18 she moved from her native Sicily to Rome where she still lives.

# ANTONIO BANNÒ - Santo

He attended the Scuola di recitazione Stabile in Genoa as well as several specialization courses, seminars and internships. For cinema, in 2017 he starred in Go Home - at their home directed by Luna Gualano and for television in Rocco Schiavone 2 directed by Michele Soavi in the role of Davide Mariotti (2017). He frequently acts in theatre, in 2017/18 in King Lear directed by Giorgio Barberio Corsetti, in 2016/17 in La cucina di Valerio Binasco, Ritratto di una nazione directed by Fabrizio Arcuri, Il gioco dell'amore e del caso directed by Lorenzo Lavia, Il funerale del padrone directed by Massimo de Michele, Egle, the Queen of the Serpents directed by Oskaras Korsunovas and others.

## **GILLES PRIVAT - Henry**

After a piano baccalaureate in Geneva in 1979, Gilles Privat studied at the Jacques Lecoq school in Paris from 1979 to 1981. He was a resident of the Comédie Française from 1996 to 1998. He works with the greatest directors, including Alain Françon, Matthias Langhoff and Benno Besson, of whom he is one of the most loyal actors. In cinema, he played among others in La crise and Romuald et Juliette by Coline Serreau.

## **MAURIZIO TABANI - Augusto**

Maurizio Tabani was born in Bergamo and trained in the Scuola di recitazione del Teatro Tascabile with teachers of the calibre of Ernesto Pagani, Alarico Salairoli and Renzo Vescovi. He is part of numerous theater companies in Bergamo, Milan and the province. At the cinema he played in Milano Underground by Giovanni Esposito (2014), Io, Arlecchino, by Matteo Bini and Giorgio Pasotti (2012), Romanzo di una Strage by Marco Tullio Giordana (2012), I Giorni della Vendemmia by Marco Righi (2010), Barbarossa by Renzo Martinelli (2009), Il Resto della Notte by Francesco Munzi (2008), Hotel Meina by Carlo Lizzani (2007), Il Mattino ha l'Oro in Bocca by Francesco Patierno (2007), Casomai by Alessandro D'Alatri (2002).

# **AMKA FILMS - production company**

Tiziana Soudani founded Amka Films in 1988 and has since been committed to producing independent works mainly in Europe but also in Africa and elsewhere.
