SYNOPSIS

Senegal, Rwanda, Mozambique, Kenya, Ivory Coast and Burundi are the birthplaces of women who in Mohammed Soudani's film represent the symbol of the rebirth of a continent torn apart by genocide, hunger and war. Society's revenge is not a story of men, but of vanguard women who, despite pressures, obstacles and increasingly difficult challenges, recount their success in the failed history of the continent's last 70 years.

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

75 years have passed since African countries gained independence. Since then, many projects have been put in place to make Africa become an independent economic power. We can certainly say that the result was catastrophic, or, worse, a total failure.

We know that dictatorship is the number one interest among presidents of African countries and it's well understood that almost the whole continent lives under a dictatorship with a backward economy. We also know that the former European colonisers never wanted a truly developed and autonomous Africa. Today other countries such as China and Japan are taking over.

I met and carefully listened to women of all categories: from those who have access to the highest reaches because they have studied hard, to those who have been cast aside because they have never been to school, but are very active within society.

The meetings, the discussions and debates which gave life to this project impose themselves on our conscience. I tried to put into images the stories of women who work, who struggle daily, who don't think about defeat and never give up in spite of their suffering, their fights, the desolation around them. They are the hope of a new Africa. My main objective was to give voice and convey their intimate beliefs, and to understand the causes and legitimate revolts of every woman who has decided to go through with it. These are testimonies from women who are not afraid and are ready to act.

This film, in which my wife and producer Tiziana Soudani believed from the very beginning, was developed with her support right up to the end of shooting and is dedicated to her.

DIRECTOR'S BIOGRAPHY AND FILMOGRAPHY

Mohammed Soudani 1949 – Algerian and Swiss citizenship

Born in 1949 in El-Asnam, Algeria, Mohammed Soudani emigrated to Ticino, Switzerland, 30 years ago, where he became one of the most appreciated and creative Swiss film and television directors. Very sensitive to the African situation and relations with Europe, he won the 1998 Swiss Film Award in Solothurn as Best Fiction Film with "Waalo Fendo (la où la terre gèle)".

A cameraman for Algerian television from 1970 to 1971, after studying at IDHEC (Institut des Hautes Ecoles Cinématographiques) in Paris, he worked first as a cameraman and then as director of photography at Polivideo SA in Switzerland until 1986. During this period, in 1980, he trained as a director of photography in the United States.



Amka Films Productions is active in the film and television production of feature films and documentaries. Founded in 1987 by Tiziana Soudani (1955-2020) and Mohammed Soudani (director of *Waalo Fendo*, Swiss Film Award 1998, Best Fiction Film), it became a public limited company in 1988. Among many others, Amka Films produced the box-office hit *Bread and Tulips* by Silvio Soldini, the award-winning *Happy as Lazzaro* by Alice Rohrwacher, and the recent *Favolacce (Bad Tales)* by the D'Innocenzo brothers.

Michela Pini studied at the University of Brescia, where she graduated in Film Sciences. She has worked as executive producer in several productions and for several directors such as Alice Rohrwacher, Ursula Meier, Denis Rabaglia and Daniele Ciprì. She is a member of GARP (Groupe suisse auteurs, réalisateurs et producteurs) and the Solothurn Swiss Film Days Society (SGSF - Schweizerische Gesellschaft Solothurner Filmtage). She is also president of the Ticino Film Commission and member of the AFAT committee, the Ticino Film and Audiovisual Association. She has participated in several workshops such as Cannes Producers Network, Torino FeatureLab, FI-DLab Marseille, Berlinale Talents Berlin, Ekran+ Warsavia and Production Value Helsinki.

Amel Soudani studied at IULM University in Milan, where she graduated in Public Relations and Advertising and completed her studies with a Master in Business and Management at the HTW in Chur. After working as casting and press office for several Swiss films, she started working at Rete Tre (RSI Radiotelevisione svizzera) as Community Manager and Multimedia Assistant. She then worked for two years at FDFA Presence Switzerland as Head of Digital Communication for Expo Milano 2015. In 2016, she became head of communications and member of the board of director of the Locarno Film Festival. From 2018 to 2020 she has worked as a communication and operations consultant for the Compagnia Finzi Pasca, for which she actively participated in the Fête des Vignerons project in Vevey. Amel is also member of the Swiss Cinema Academy and of the board of AFAT (Ticino Film and Audiovisual Association).

CAST INTERVIEWED WOMEN

YVONNE ERIE - Ivory Coast

She is the manager of the large Gourò Market (fruit and vegetables), entirely run by women. One of Abidjan's most active entrepreneurs in the food sector, she has become a model for hundreds of women, an example of strength through union. She has never forgotten the working-class neighbourhood of Adjamé where she comes from.

LEONI OSSO SONA - Ivory Coast

Hers is a small cocoa plantation compared to those of the big multinationals, but it is the only one entirely owned by women.

MARIANNE TENENG N'DAY - Senegal

Marianne, alongside about fifty other women, continues to work in fish processing handed down from generation to generation, despite the climate crisis and competition from Chinese and Koreans, which have made their work increasingly difficult.







MARGUERITE BARANKITSE – Burundi/Rwanda

A humanitarian activist who works to improve the welfare of children and challenge ethnic discrimination in Burundi. After rescuing 25 children from a massacre, she was forced to witness the conflicts between the Hutu and Tutsi in her country in 1993. She established Maison Shalom, a shelter that provided access to healthcare, education, and culture to over 20,000 orphan children in need. Because she protested against a third term for President Nkurunziza, she lives in exile. During the 26 years that it operated in Burundi, Maison Shalom grew into a large network of schools, hospitals, and healthcare services across the country.

WANGARI MAATHAI - Kenya

(1 April 1940 - 25 September 2011)

Wangari Muta Maathai was a renowned Kenyan social, environmental and political activist and the first African woman to win the Nobel Prize in 2004. She founded the Green Belt Movement, an environmental NGO focused on the planting of trees, environmental conservation, and women's rights. Maathai was an elected member of Parliament and served as assistant minister for Environment and Natural resources in the government of President Mwai Kibaki.
